### LAKE CHAMPLAIN VOYAGES OF DISCOVERY: BRINGING HISTORY HOME THE CHAMPLAIN VALLEY 1500 - 1776

Location: Addison County, Vermont, DAR State Park and vicinity

**Hands-On learning Through  
Archeology, History, Material Culture, Primary Sources, Maps,  
Computers, and Other Tools**

Offered as a 1 or 2 week option, the Program includes daily morning archeological excavations at a French period site in the Town of Addison and daily afternoon mini-seminars on a rich variety of topics, including curriculum development, Native American prehistory, Contact with Europeans and its consequences, French settlement history, material culture, archeological laboratory techniques, use of primary sources, reading and using old and new maps, computer applications to enhance history teaching, and other topics.

**1 Week Session (\$ 75.00)** The same basic session is offered both weeks.

Choose ONE of these:

- July 16 – July 20
- July 23 – July 27

**2 Week Session (\$ 150.00)**

Choose BOTH of these:

- July 16 – July 20
- July 23 – July 27

You will attend the July 16 – 20 basic week. During the second week, you'll experience MORE: archeological excavation and laboratory analysis; research in primary archives; engagement with different educators and different guest speakers; a “product” development; and more Credits.

Certificate awarded for 45 or 90 hours of professional development -- HQT credits available. 3, 6, or 9 Graduate Credits may be available for \$ 133.00/credit – the program is now being evaluated by the University of Vermont. We will know by end of June.

**MORNINGS 8:00 AM - Noon:** History Through Archeology - - Site Excavation

**LUNCH HOUR:** Time to relax, informal debriefing, occasional guest speaker

**AFTERNOONS 1:00 PM – 5:00 PM:** A series of consecutive Mini-Seminars

**EVENING LECTURE (Most likely 1 per week)**

**Monday afternoon:** Discuss readings (a packet will be sent in June); Curriculum development; Native American prehistory of the Champlain Valley; Champlain Valley 1500 AD – 1700 AD -- Late pre-contact and Contact period history; Impact of European Contact on Native Americans; Curriculum discussion. Includes material culture, foodstuffs, disease, complexity of cultures and relationships among them, and a great deal more. Curriculum discussion.

**Tuesday afternoon:** Discuss readings; French History of the Champlain Valley; Using Archival Sources to Teach History; Curriculum discussion. Includes material culture, foodstuffs, architecture, literature, and a great deal more.

**Wednesday afternoon:** Discuss readings; Reading and Using Maps (Old Maps and New Maps -- Google Earth, VTArcheoMap, other digital maps); the “Best” of the internet for teaching archeology and history; Reading historic landscapes; Curriculum discussion.

**Thursday afternoon:** Discuss readings; Archeology laboratory, analyzing material culture, and other types of data to interpret culture and lifeways; Curriculum discussion.

**Friday afternoon:** Discuss readings; Teaching through Material Culture; 3 D Software for interactive learning and other digital tools; Final curriculum discussion; Wrap-up.
